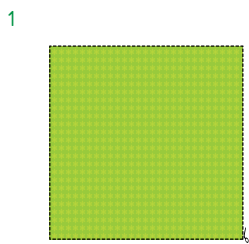
DISEMBOWEL BODIES WITH PERCIVAL THE PLAYFUL PENGUIN



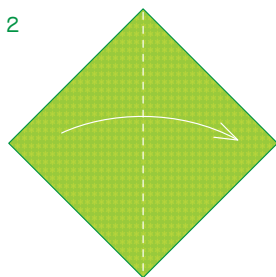

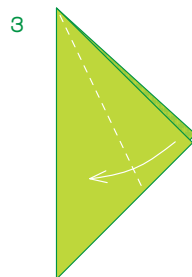

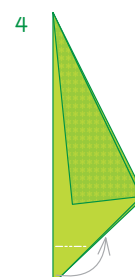
1 Cut out the origami square above



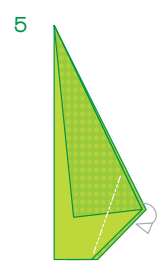
2 Fold it diagonally in half



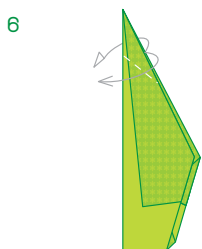
3 Form Percival's wings like so



4 Make his feet by folding the bottom tip inside.

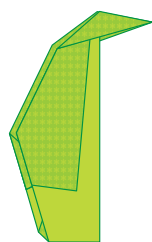


5 Two more internal folds at the back

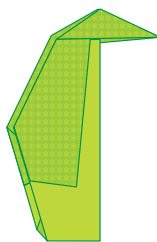


6 Bend down the top to create the head

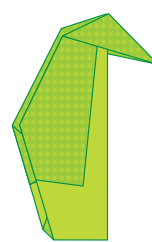
Adjust the angle of Percival's head to reflect his mood.
